January 12, 2007 our beautiful, healthy, 9 year old daughter Jenna was very suddenly diagnosed with a brain tumor. She had a craniotomy on January 15, 2007 to try to remove the tumor. We found that the tumor grew back within a year and she had another Craniotomy on June 3, 2008. We brought her home from the hospital to recover and immediately started doing research on this tumor called a Pilocytic Astrocytoma. To our dismay we found that no research is being done. The treatments that are being used are 20+ years old and have not been proved effective on this type of tumor. We have since partnered with The Pediatric Low Grade Astrocytoma Foundation to try to get some research done. Please join us in our quest to save our daughter and many other children suffering with this terrible disease. We are truly in a race against time.
