Don't Wash It Down The Drain

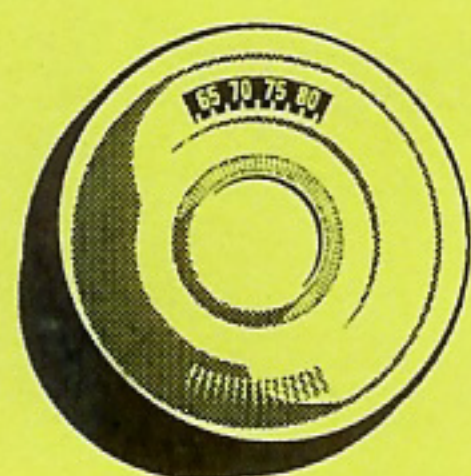

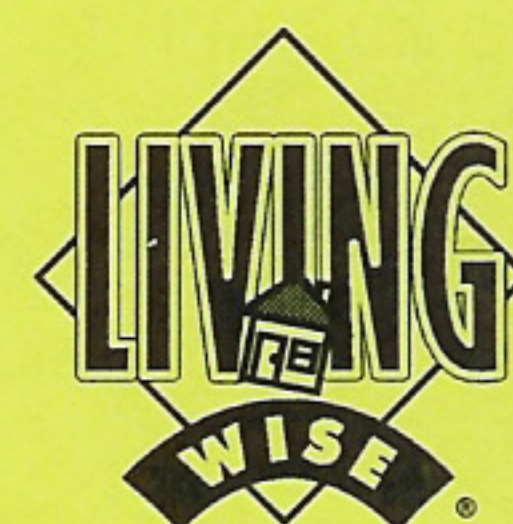
